



Thank you for your interest in EENP's Release Dog program. Finding the right home for each of our pups is important to us, and we're excited to explore the possibility of placing one of our pups with you. Below is an overview of the application process.

To be put on our waiting list, please:

- Complete and return the enclosed application.
- Provide a letter of reference recommending you as a dog owner. The letter should be written by a veterinarian, dog training instructor, dog owner, or other non-family member who can speak to your ability to care for a dog. *Please have your reference send the letter directly to EENP.*
- We will contact you to let you know you've been put on our waiting list or if we have further questions about your situation.

Once we have a possible pup for you:

- EENP will contact you to schedule a time to meet the pup.
- EENP will schedule a home visit and the deposit is due at this time.

Before placement:

- Payment is required in full.
- The adopting family must sign an adoption contract.

FREQUENTLY ASKED QUESTIONS

HOW LONG WILL I HAVE TO WAIT?

We have no good estimates on wait time, but you are welcome to contact us to find out where you are on the wait list and what dogs may come available.

HOW MUCH DOES IT COST?

Each pet dog placement is priced individually, based on a number of factors including how much training the dog has received and the reason for release. In most cases, the fee ranges from \$500-\$2,500. No donation or payment is due until a home visit has been scheduled.

WHAT IS INCLUDED?

Pups will all be spayed/neutered and up-to-date on their vaccinations. A full copy of health records will be provided. The reason for release will be included in the adoption contract.
